



God has inspired our hearts with a great vision for the future. We believe provision also comes with this inspiration. Architectural estimates indicate it will take \$1.5 million to build the first phase of our new church home. We have approximately \$200,000 to apply toward the building, plus we will save \$31,000 per year in portable costs (e.g., lease, etc.), which can also be applied to the project. Our prayer is to receive commitments sufficient to begin construction as soon as possible. We anticipate a follow-up campaign to complete the needed funding.

The tables below illustrate gifts needed to raise \$300,000 and \$500,000 in three-year pledges. Pledges become leverage to get the project started. The chart is based on 60 households with approximately 70% making a commitment. With God’s help, the church will grow over the next three years, and there will be a plan in place to involve new families in making commitments.
